

## Guidance for League Matches and Rollup Sessions

This document is based on the EIBA's Road map out of COVID-19 Restrictions Update, 15<sup>th</sup> July 2021

### Covid-19 :

1. As from 19<sup>th</sup> July the government removed all mandatory Covid-19 restrictions. As a result:
  - a. There are no restrictions on participant numbers indoors which means that all formats of the Indoor Bowls are permitted.
  - b. Social distancing measures have been removed.
  - c. There is no legal requirement to wear a face covering when entering or walking round the club. However, the Government does recommend that people should continue to wear them in crowded and enclosed spaces.
  - d. There is no legal requirement to collect contact details. However, people are requested to record their name and contact telephone number in the sign-in book when they enter the club. The NHS QR code will continue to be displayed for those wishing to check via the app.
  - e. Hygiene measures to reduce the risk of transmission will be kept in place and hand sanitisers are available around the club.
  - f. The tradition of shaking hands pre- and post-match is left to the individual participants
  - g. For the bar and restaurant areas there are no restrictions on numbers allowed to sit or stand in the area. Table service is no longer a requirement.
  - h. There are no specific restrictions on numbers using the changing rooms, but members and visitors should avoid overcrowding.
  - i. Members and visitors displaying Covid-19 symptoms (cough, temperature and loss of taste/smell) should not enter the club.
  - j. Members must book a rink for a roll-up prior to attending the club. This can be done using the Rink Management System menu option on the club's website – <http://www.cdibc.co.uk> . When booking a rink, the names of all the players should be specified.

### Prior to Arrival:

1. The club is now fully open. For roll-ups, members must book a rink prior to attending the club and this can be done using the Rink Management System menu option on the club's website – <http://www.cdibc.co.uk> . When booking a rink, the names of all the players should be specified.
2. Players for roll-ups and League matches should arrive at the club early enough to give them time to make their payments and to change into their bowling attire before the session is due to start.

### On Arrival:

1. Members and visitors must not enter the club if they are displaying Covid-19 symptoms.
2. It is recommended that members and visitors should complete a temperature check on entering the club.
3. Players should also sanitize their hands and then complete the sign-in book.
4. Players should then make their way to the changing rooms where there should change into their bowling attire. Bowls bags must be left in the changing room. It is not permitted to leave bowls bags in the other areas of the club, such as the entrance hall or bar and restaurant areas.
5. On leaving the changing room players should place their bowls in the racks provided until they are ready to make their way to the green.
6. At the reception desk players should make the appropriate payment for their roll-up or league match.
7. Players should **not** make their way to their rink until the start of session warning bell (4x 1 second) has sounded. Players should avoid entering the playing area until all the players from the previous session have left their rink.
8. Once players have arrived at their rink, play may commence once the start of session bell (1x 2 seconds) has sounded

### Catering and Bar

1. In addition to the bar and catering facilities, a drink vending machine is available for use. Players may consume their beverages in the bar and restaurant area or next to their rink. Beverages must **not** be taken onto the green. Please ensure empty cups are disposed of in the bin provided.
2. Food (including sweets) must **not** be taken passed the wall that is in front of the playing area.

### At the end of the game:

1. When the end of session warning bell (2x 1 second) rings **do not** start any further ends. Please make every effort to leave the playing area as quickly as possible when the end of session bell (3x 1 second) rings. Ensure you take all belongings with you, including drinks containers which should be disposed of in the appropriate bin.
